



The Twelfth Triennial Convention is scheduled for September 19-21, 2023 with the Gathering immediately following on September 21-24 in Phoenix, Arizona. The convention, the highest legislative authority in Women of the ELCA, will be held at the Sheraton Phoenix Downtown. Voting members, elected in the 64 synodical women’s organizations, will conduct the business of the

organization. They will elect leaders for the 2023-2026 triennium, act on memorials from synodical organizations and resolutions from the floor, approve a budget and much more.

If you registered for the 2020 Triennial and did not get the refund, you are still registered! New registrations begin on March 1, 2023. As the ability to meet in-person has steadily increased over the past year, there has been successful collections at the seven In-Gathering locations in August 2022. Collections were below pre-pandemic levels, donations of Quilts & Kits is expected to rise.. In August, 55 churches participated – nine of which were non-ELCA and three were from outside the boundaries of the Southeastern Synod.

The 2023 In-Gathering locations are listed on the Lutheran World Relief (LWR) website. LWR does pay for the trucks to come to the sites and then deliver donations to their warehouse in Maryland, but it is vital that congregational units send a donations to the shipping fund directed to the board treasurer.

Many thanks are extended to the site coordinators and volunteers who load the trucks with donations at In-Gathering sites: Mary Jane Gray, Tommie Morgan, Joni Donegan, Roberta Stamp, Sandy Gibson, and Rhonda Gaede!

CALL TO CONVENTION 2023

The Women of the Southeastern Synod of the ELCA are heading to Augusta, Georgia in 2023 for our 35th Annual Convention to be held at the Augusta Marriott at the Convention Center right along the Riverwalk in downtown Augusta. There is so much to do within walking distance of the Hotel and Convention Center and of course, there is golfing galore in the Augusta area (The Masters is held there in the spring, so invite your spouses to come too!)

Hotel reservations should be made directly with the Augusta Marriott by calling 1-888-236-2427. You must register *no later than September 1* to receive the posted rate of \$145.00 per night. Rooms will be released after September 1. If you prefer to book your room online click on this link: [Book your group rate for 35th Southeastern SYNOD Women of the ELCA Convention Sep2023](#). Parking facilities are owned by the City of Augusta and guests staying will be charged \$7.00 per day/night to their room portfolio.

There are several general scholarships of \$100 that may be used toward your registration fee. There is also the *Whitney Hill Memorial Fund* which provides \$100 for a young woman 35 or under, and the *Caroline P. Gammell Memorial Fund* for a woman over the age of 65. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. The deadline to apply for a scholarship is July 1, 2023. Please contact Board President, Shirley Connelly at sconnelly@gmail.com for an application. Names and information submitted for scholarships are kept strictly confidential.

Each congregational or special unit of the Southeastern Synod Women of the ELCA is entitled to one voting member. It is very important that all congregations be represented as we conduct the business of our organization. This year SES-WELCA will be electing a president, treasurer, and three board members. Amendments to the bylaws now allows up to two people from the same congregation to serve on the board, if one serves as an officer, and one serves as a board member.
